

The Style of Manuscript for 42nd Annual Conference of the RSJ

From 2023, authors are encouraged to write an article's abstract. Abstracts should be 3-6 lines long (100 words or less). If authors use simultaneous submission of the [Letter], an abstract is required. If authors are not using simultaneous submission and will submit the article in English to other journals in the future, an abstract in English is not recommended due to the risk of being considered self-plagiarism.

1. General instructions for the manuscript

The paper submission procedure for the International Sessions is basically the same as that for other regular sessions. For details, please refer to the International Session website [1] for the 42nd RSJ annual conference.

1. **[Microsoft Word]:** Please write your manuscript using the sample file, sample2024e.doc which can be downloaded from the website [1]. Differences of the versions of your MS Word or OS may cause changes of the layout. Please arrange your manuscript according to the sample PDF file.

[LaTeX]: When typesetting by LaTeX, please download sample2024e.zip from the website [1] and use the included files.

[Typst]: Typst is a new typesetting system. The RSJ2024 committee provides a template suite for those authors who intend to use Typst for their manuscripts. Please download sample2024e_typ.zip from the website [1], extract it, and modify the included files.

[Other cases]: The manuscript should be written in accordance with the sample file in PDF format sample2024e.pdf.

2. You must create a PDF file from a DVI file or Word file etc. Please refer to the website [1] for the embedded font, the quality of graphics, and the security setup. Before submitting the PDF file, please double-check your file by using Adobe Reader.
3. Follow the paper submission procedure described on the website [1]. The uploaded PDF file will be included in the conference proceedings.
4. It is strongly recommended for the authors who are willing to submit papers to the International Sessions contact the corresponding session organizers before submitting the paper. They will check the fitting of your paper to their session.

2. Format of the manuscript

2.1 Number of pages and file size

The manuscript for the International Sessions must be in English, and up to 4 pages of A4 size paper. The sizes of the PDF file should not exceed 3M bytes. You can submit video file for a reference material. The total size of the video file and the main paper PDF file should be




Fig. 1 Sample image

less than 4M bytes. Manuscripts exceeding 4 pages cannot be published and files exceeding the regulated sizes cannot be submitted.

2.2 Paper layout

Submitted manuscripts will be published in the proceedings as is. Please be careful not to write the manuscript inappropriately. Please follow the guidelines described on the website [1] for the structure of a paper written in English.

2.2.1 Figures and Tables

The manuscripts of the papers are PDF files, so you can use figures and tables created in color. The figures and tables should have sufficient resolution for printing. Note, however, that the total file size including figures should not exceed the maximum file size (3M bytes).

2.2.2 References

In the main text, each reference citation should be enclosed in brackets as [2], and all references should be listed together at the end of the manuscript. Their formats are based on those of the Journal of the Robotics Society of Japan. Again, please refer to the website [1] for details.

3. Application for presentation and paper submission

The application for the presentation and the paper submission for the International Sessions are the same as that for the regular sessions. Each contributor must apply for the presentation through the conference website, and then upload the manuscript in PDF format. Please keep the deadline strict. For details, please refer to the website [1].
